From Dreams to Reality: Become a Professional Nurse



Rady Children's Hospital's Weekend Medical Academy (WMA) programs provide a condensed learning opportunity for students interested in pursuing healthcare careers. WMA programs address timely healthcare topics and related careers through lectures/interactive discussions, hands-on skills clinics and career panels.







The WMA program, From Dreams to Reality: Become a Professional Nurse, took place May 4-6, 2018 with 24 engaged students from throughout San Diego County, and even Texas and Nevada. Students learned about the history, philosophy, and importance of the nursing profession; how to become a nurse; and the variety of positions and work done by nurses in both hospitals and the community. Throughout the weekend, students learned from 31 professional nurses from Rady Children's Hospital, San Diego State University, and CSU-San Marcus. WMA participant learning included:




