What is the Advanced Medical Academy?

What will you do?

- **Hands-on skills clinics** to practice key skills with leading interventional cardiologists.
- **Career panels** during which faculty will share their stories, experience, and advice.

Who should apply?

Students interested in a career in healthcare, in particular cardiology. Only Medical Academy Alumni & FACES for the Future students (incoming 12th grade students) are eligible.

How much does it cost?

Tuition is \$175 and covers all program materials; t-shirt; and meals. Parking at Rady Children's is included; transportation is not included. Proceeds from the Academy help support the FACES for the Future program at Rady Children's & tuition is partially tax deductible.
